Report of the Handbook Editor

In response to a question at the May meeting, I reviewed the paragraph about incorporation at the bottom of page 1 of the *Area 31 Handbook and Guidelines*. The paragraph was out of date and confusing. Here is the new paragraph, written in consultation with Area Officers and Area Committee Members, and after reviewing Massachusetts and IRS records.

Western Massachusetts General Service Area 31 of Alcoholics Anonymous, Inc. was incorporated in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts on November 3, 2006. An amendment on August 29, 2007, shortened the name to Western Massachusetts General Service Area 31, Inc. The Area is recognized by the IRS as a 501(c)3 (tax exempt) nonprofit. The Area's official address is 30 Carew Street, South Hadley, MA. Our mailing address is PO Box 6818, Holyoke, MA 01041.

I will submit a revised edition of the Handbook, the 34th update since an Ad Hoc Committee produced the 2016 version, and the Area began maintaining a web version. Once the revision is posted, the editorship will move from me to Janet B. My thanks to Janet for agreeing to take this on, and my deep thanks to the Area for allowing me to serve.
