Linds B.: GSR, Trials & Smiles, Two Speaker Meeting. Pot Luck Dinner on the 3rd Friday @ 6:30pm before the meeting for Fellowship continues. Have a Commitment @ The Hope Center on The 3rd Monday of the Month & the Fourth Friday of the Month have a commitment @ Detox. New members & new young people. Treasury is good. Giving to the Pie.

Julie: GSR, Spanish AA, State/School Tuesday.-Two Issues is Attendance has been kinda low. Many members join, 10-12, but then when it's time to set up & do stuff the same 2 or 3 people are doing everything. Trying to get the Spanigh population to participate in English events is very difficult.

Launa T.: GSR, New Hope, Attendance has been down about 30-40% @ our Speaker meeting & about 30-35% @ our Beginner's meeting. As a result our Treasury has been down as well, about 50%. At our business meeting we voted to stop buying doughnuts & switch to cookies. To save \$\$\$. Which will help our Treasury a Great Deal. The Smoking issue...we are COMPLETELY NON SMOKING. Everyone Must Go to The Bus Stop to Smoke. We've even put it into our format that if they have difficulty with this than they can find another meeting to attend, thus they may have done so.
