GROUP REPORTS

Experiencing some growing pains, volatility in business meeting due to clashing personalities surrounding meeting format (i.e., hybrid vs in person meetings); losing group members, possibly due to this ongoing debate. DCM REPORT

- Attended Area meeting Wednesday 7/13
- Area registrar is asking that groups that meet online and have no plans to return in person update their status to be an online group. We only have 2 registered online groups in our area. There may be as many as 31 such groups
- Archives located a document in storage from the first Pittsfield AA meeting. The group wrote the AA Foundation (our name at the time) in 1945 to report that the first group was starting with 3 members and several prospects. They were receiving support from Albany and from Springfield. No mention of a group name is given, but it would supercede our current oldest group (Central Berkshire) by 10 years.
- Invited committees (anyone can attend or join. All groups are encouraged to send a representative to each committee.)
- Accessibilities continues to develop the accessibility checklist. They started an in person commitment to
 a homebound individual. They assisted another individual who is low-literacy by providing audio tapes
 of our big book.
- Archives committee reports working on an interview format for oldtimers to build up our history
- CPC is back to doing interactive presentations. They are working with Elms college and also are
 planning a presentation to the Emergency Nurses Group of Palmer
- Grapevine reports that the Grapevine store is being reworked. There is also a new app in development and should be ready in about a year. They produced a video that explains the group's Grapevine rep's role. The Grapevine is looking for stories on making amends with a submission deadline of 8/15
- PI continues to plan for our radio show which has been restarted as a new program airing on 94.7 on Sunday at 5am. New format is more of an interview than just giving your story. Open to all AA members. Studio time is limited to Tu-Thu 1-4pm
- Institutions has a huge surplus of books. If you put on a commitment, you are welcome to literature regardless of whether the commitment is through the Institutions committee or not. Attend the meeting to receive literature.
- Western MA Intergroup will be having their annual picnic 8/28 from 11am-5pm at the Moose Lodge in Chicopee on Fuller Rd. There will be a band, DJ, bounce house, face painting, raffles, and cheap food.

- New Business was what to do with the Area's Surplus of money. No motion was made, but discussion was encouraged at the meeting and until the next area meeting. The Area has operating funds of \$28,500 and a prudent reserve of \$8500, totaling about \$37k.
- Our district's budget was misrepresented as \$300 instead of \$800, but it was merely a typo and no
 motion was needed to fix it.

DISCUSSION – Acknowledged that Area has a surplus of money as expenses have been low the previous 2 years. Possible ways in which the money might be used:

- Supporting in full the Delegate's travel expenses
- Increasing support of NERASSA travel expenses
- Technology
- Subsidize conventions and round-ups (both have their own funds)
