New Business: Need to know if anyone has a desire to chair the mtg. assigned to us at NERASSA on Saturday 27th 11:00 PM – 12:00 AM (CONFIRMED) (will need to jot down their contact info. For the planning committee) – we had a concern that two districts were assigned the same time. Jae and Jade volunteered to co-chair the meeting. Format will be predetermined. Jade ###-####. Patti added that they are looking for people, even local, to book rooms at the Sheraton. Sue explained that in order for AA to get a discount on the hotel for conference, we have to get enough attendees to book rooms and buy meals. It was also suggested that home groups could reasonably pay the way for GSR's to

attend for the \$20 fee. (Chapter 2 of Service manual supports this). Sue will confirm the double booking and it's not breaking tradition to pay your own way.

We should begin to think about a workshop, primarily where it might best be held to serve the District, Let's start a little conversation/dialog to let GSR's know this is expected of them! We want to put it around a time that isn't around the same time as another bigger AA event in order to not affect attendance. We need topics. K.C. suggested not doing it in the fall as that time has too many workshops. We will talk more about it after NERAASA.

Jade brought up another topic for new business. How do we as GSR's get more AA members and groups to donate? KC reminded that each group is autonomous. Jade suggested just bringing up at meetings that AA is hurting for money (in general). Alex brought up the problem of new meetings that pop up that don't give to the pie. Patti reminded that not all the groups with GSR's representing are actually reported as having donated, so we should check back with our groups to confirm pie donations. All the sublets of the Eye Opener get reported as existing but not as donating, since they give to the main Eye Opener group which then gives to the pie. So one group gets the credit for several group donations. Ben suggested that even though we can't tell others how to run their groups, we can share our own experiences with how we work our service and provide an example. Tania suggested the pamphlet on how spirituality and money mix. In her previous group, after reading about how putting the hand of service out there (and in the basket), their incoming donations doubled. Molly suggested educating members (newcomers) on where the money goes (not just for coffee). Sally suggested General Service Office puts out "the green card" which has language useful for meeting formats. She also suggested our GSR's could try to make contact with GSR's of other groups and find a way to talk and get them to come here.
