### G.S.R. Reports

Of note was a discussion from the Greenfield Sunday AM meeting that some dissension had arisen regarding a meeting format change. The point centered around one person taking responsibility for making the changes without the benefit of group consciousness. It was suggested that to best serve the group and avoid conflicts, such decisions should be taken to a vote with a minimum of a majority or even a two-thirds vote necessary to institute such format changes.

A discussion was also generated regarding asking groups to make regular donations to the Pie Chart rather than irregular lump donations. Several representatives stated that there was resistance to this due to the increased work for the treasurer as well the irregular nature of the groups income. It was pointed out that the recipient committees have appreciated and benefited from those that have shifted to a regular donation and that GSR's should continue to encourage their group to try and make regular donations vs. irregular lump sums.
