- Call to order at 7:00pm

 - Susan from Conway Monday Night: Attendance has been varying. People are shy in sharing, but they can talk with other members and hear experience, strength, and hope over the phone. Talked about zoom fatigue.
 - Arthur from Valley LGBTQ Thursday Night Meeting: The group chose not to get a full-year plan on zoom and are paying month to month. There is more interest in the group in terms of how to do commitments and do speaking engagements at institutions.
 - Linda from Sunderland Security: Just had the one-year anniversary on zoom.
 Have about 50-60 people there per meeting. The group does commitments and does many of the things the group would normally do.
 - Sam from Haydenville Sunday Night Life Group (Dan B Alt-GSR): Have a solid core group that does many commitments. Attendance is lower than it was in person, but the group has faith that when meetings return in person the numbers will rise. Everything is going well.
