Their community building activity was a bonfire that around 25 people attended and a game night. They do 2 commitments each week: Bridge House and Women's Correctional Center in Chicopee.

<u>Will C - Only Requirement</u> 6:00 PM Sunday held at the Grapevine. Attendance has been affected by football season. They are experiencing difficulty in getting people for commitments. Will's role as GSR will be up in February.

<u>Terri S - Saturday Beginner's Meeting</u> in Northampton 7:00 PM. Service positions are all filled. Terri is finishing her role as GSR and Nancy is the alternate. Six people attended the business meeting in a group of 70 people. They are planning to change the GSR position to one year. The group has a lot of beginners.

Rick K (alternate) - Sunday Night Life Group in Haydenville 7:30 PM. The group is having their 42nd anniversary on Sunday, November 19th 7:30 PM with fellowship at 6:30 PM. The group is trying to encourage more diversity in their membership.

Nancy P - Shelburne Falls Big Book study group. The group has had 24 people in attendance although more commonly there are 18 in attendance. There are new faces at the meeting and newly sober people. The group is not doing much general service. The group has contributed \$50 to the church and the rest to the pie chart.

<u>Dana - Conway Group</u> meets Monday 7:00 PM on-line. The group will be celebrating their 43rd anniversary. They have just elected a bookie for making commitments. They would like to learn how to take donations virtually.

Bonnie - New Perspectives Women's Meeting in Hadley on Wednesday 6:30-7:30 PM is a hybrid group. We have 20 -25 people in-person and 5-6 on Zoom. Attendance is fluctuating upward right now.

Adam (for Doug) - Attitude Adjustment Group 7:00 AM for 7 days a week at the Grapevine in Greenfield. They need more people to volunteer for commitments.

Tradition 10 Alcoholics Anonymous has no opinion on outside issues; hence the AA name ought never to be drawn into public controversy.

Dana shared that getting sober is life and death so conflict over other matters detracts from that message. A similar group, the Washingtonians had 100,000 members and did get into politics which led to its demise. She appreciates that AA doesn't get involved in rebutting criticism of AA and that it keeps the fellowship open to all people.
