Revisions to the 12 & 12 approved at the 2021 General Service Conference:

The revision to page 117, will replace the phrase "opposite sex" with the word "partner." A footnote will be added to provide context to the change as it relates to inclusivity.

The sentence which includes the phrase "lustful enough to rape" in paragraph one on page 66, be revised to refer to the Seven Deadly Sins without specific mention of examples that are severe in nature, and that a footnote be added to provide context as to the basis for the change.
