From Charlie: A quick note of thanks to the PI chair, who was the point of contact to make us aware of the resumed interest at Mill Street. Also from Charlie: Regarding quorum, our guidelines are not specific as to the number of people (IGRs) who must be present for a vote. The guidelines might be read to suggest that the majority ("one half plus one") could be counted of the members present at the time of the vote, or counted at the time the motion was put forward (in this specific case, the number in attendance at the March meeting was 43, meaning that 23 votes would be needed). One alternative to in-person voting at Providence discussed is the possibility of holding an outdoor in-person meeting with a simultaneous on-line component. Connell also reminded us that participation in a Zoom meeting only requires a telephone; anyone with a phone can connect.
