In February, the Corrections Activity Update came out with information from the GSO (corrections@aa.org, Brenda, the coordinator for corrections at GSO) about the Grapevine Program that has been distributed to many alcoholics behind bars at no charge as a way of sharing the AA message in the absence of in-person commitments (the Carry the Message Project). AA is also facilitating correspondence between alcoholics behind bars and AAs on the outside (see aa.org for details). "Sharing Behind the Walls" is a quarterly newsletter from the GSO for AAs behind bars discussing various efforts that groups and area committees around the country have been doing for outreach to inmates and others in facilities. AA world services had been struggling for donations for some time, but 2020 ended with record donations globally with \$10 million in total donations, and the percentage of revenues from literature sales is decreasing with respect to general donations. In other words, AA is reducing its dependency
