The CPC Boards: Matt H. investigated the available sizes, durability, and costs of replacing our current Boards. We had discussion and are going to vote on the purchase of the 33"x 81" board(s) next month. They will cost \$199-\$224 each. We are to also determine if one will be enough or if we need to purchase two. We also discussed the time it will take to get the graphics we want and how long it will take for the graphics to be finalized onto the boards (2-3 weeks is standard). We are likely to hold a "design the Boards" meeting on a non-committee meeting day. All of the committee will be invited to help put this together. Lastly, Bruce may have one to bring in for us to view before we vote next month.
